

To assist Leadership Scholarship Candidates prepare their presentation prior to delivery to the ASP this Marking Guide is to be distributed to all candidates.

CANDIDATES ARE TO:

1. Be nominated via 41 RNSWR to the Association Scholarship Panel (ASP). The Leadership selection criteria and eligibility criteria are detailed in the – Guideline, 41st Infantry Battalion Association Leadership Scholarship. This guideline can be located at www.41bnassoc.com.au in the Scholarship section.
2. Selected Candidates are to deliver a timed 15 minute presentation at Byron Barracks to the ASP.
 - a. A multimedia Presentation of the topic is the delivery method. Candidates are encouraged to prepare and present a professional presentation and may use any additional aids to enhance their presentations.
 - b. Tuesday night timing and movement to Lismore for candidate presentations to the ASP will be advised by 41 RNSWR.
3. **CANDIDATE PRESENTATION TOPIC to the ASP is:**
 - a. Select a military leader and explain why they inspire you?
 - b. What have you learnt from their actions?
 - c. What makes you a worthy candidate for this Scholarship?
 - d. What would winning this Scholarship mean to you?
4. In addition the winner of the Leadership Scholarship is required to deliver a 30 minute Multimedia presentation to the Association members as detailed in Paragraph 9 of the Guideline, 41st Infantry Battalion Association Leadership Scholarship. The topic for this presentation will provided to the Scholarship winner by the Association Chairperson after the winner is determined.
